

Hebrew and IDN

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Attributes of Hebrew

- Special alphabet:

א ב ג ד ה ו ז ח ט י כ ך ל מ ם נ ן
ס ע פ ף צ ץ ק ר ש ת

- 27 Chars (22 Basic chars + 5 Ending forms)
- Bidirectional:
 - Letters: written Right To Left ("RTL")
 - Digits: written Left To Right ("LTR")
- Other bidirectional languages: Arabic, Farsi, Urdu ...



IDN

(1) RFCs: LTR scripts & RTL scripts **MUST NOT** be on same label (3454).

Result:

www.שלום.co.il ✓

www.hello-שלום.co.il ✗

(2) ICANN: TLD to remain in Latin characters.

Result: Hebrew Domain Names must be a combination of RTL & LTR labels.

www.שלום.co.il

il.la.לישון.עכשיו

Problems with "mixed" domains (3)

(2) Non-trivial typing: **host.איזה.בלגן.il**

LTR mode in Browser:

▶ host. ~~איזה.בלגן~~.il 

RTL mode in Browser:

 ~~host~~.איזה.בלגן.il ◀



Result

- (1) Attractiveness of Hebrew Domain Names is questionable.
- (2) Original goal of IDN missed?

Solution?

- (1) A uni-directional Domain Name (i.e. Hebrew TLD ...)
- (2) Careful implementation policy and user education, i.e., non-technical.
